RECENT CASES: Roe went back-and-forth with attorneys for 15 hours before a fast food restaurant agreed to pay an eight-figure amount to the family of a 9-year-old who claimed the boy suffered brain damage after falling from an indoor play structure. In another case, Roe helped achieve a \$3.75 million settlement with Orange County for a man who was severely beaten by jail inmates after being arrested on child molestation charges. The case turned out to be a legal and political minefield because of controversy over approval of taxpayer, not insurance, funds for someone accused of such abuse. In another of Roe's mediations, which stretched over several sessions, the family of a brain-injured baby settled with a hospital for \$6.5 million after arguing the infant's condition dramatically worsened because of an inaccurate diagnosis.
